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We've Started!

We have been focusing on **FUNDRAISING** for the first few months of this year because all our goals revolve around money! Prospective donors always check out the website first, so Denny revised the content, and will be revising the design in June, allowing us to make more use of social media to get our messages across.

We submitted an application to the **Loyal Protestant Association**, who have been very generous to us in the past, and they donated \$10,000 to us for the next two years, to be able to help with bursaries for children. We are so grateful to them! We were accepted by the **BC Liquor Stores** to have our donation cans in some of their stores for the month of May – the cans are being filled up as I type. Nadine investigated Foundation Search, a database which provides information on who to ask, and how to ask, but the reviews weren't very encouraging, and the outlay was quite costly. She is currently investigating Canada Imagine. Marcelle Warnes has a fundraising site - **The Cards Project** that is also being looked into - we surely have sufficient talented artists to provide a great selection of cards!

Our **BURSARY** procedure has been updated, Anne Haegart has had our first 2017 request. Over the last 13 years we have provided \$69,500 for 49 clients via 9 Facilitators – not so shabby and long may we continue. Bursaries are available to all Canadian Facilitators; donors can specify the use; for children or adults, for a particular province. We welcome any and all additions/ideas/leads to our fundraising program.
