

many teachers as possible, and in turn as many K-3 children as we can.

Recently I worked with a student who was nearing the end of his **Vision Therapy** sessions. I have a completely undocumented personal view that when the vision therapists pick up the tracking issues, it is because the child's real eyes are trying to keep up with their Mind's Eye which is capable of 32 images a second, and unlimited travel. Up till now, I haven't been able to meet a VT who agrees with this, but K's Vision Therapist is intrigued by his success, and wants me to tell him what we did, so I am grateful for the open door. This is from K's mother:

"K's Vision Therapy. 3 of the 4 exercises were next to impossible 2 weeks ago. Today (post program)he mastered them ALL!!! the first time! Within minutes he was finished what used to take him 20 minutes of frustration for everyone. A couple times he got caught up, and I saw him close his eyes, breathe and then he corrected himself and carried on! was beaming. So am I. Amazing!"

This summer Nadine Matishak's **Flax Braking Course** will be featured at the **Harmony Arts Festival** in West Vancouver, **August 3-13**. It's always a wonderful week and this year will be even more exciting with her group's involvement.
